Having googled the phone number it transpires he is a director of Urban Vision Enterprises CIC, based in North Staffs (of all places), website <a href="http://www.uvns.org/">http://www.uvns.org/</a> Presumably they are tasked (maybe with others?) to deal with these applications, liaising with the Dept for Communities & Local Government as appropriate.

Discussed at some length how support might be given to us, and he concluded that it a package can be put together for us that will:

- · Review the process with us
- Review/rewrite our Project Plan & timings (this has become outdated since we started)
- Look at & help us put together our evidence base (in addition to our Community Engagement activities we need to extract other info. He is of the view that most – if not all- of this is already in the MasterPlan & VDS. They can identify the relevant stuff.)
- Review our Communications Strategy
- Help us review Site Allocations (this might cross with support LCC have promised, but the more the merrier. Will be useful to us post Comms Event 2)
- Write/help us write our Plan policies.

A useful discussion, but he needs to get sign-off from the Dept of Communities, which he conceded may take some weeks yet.

From our perspective we will accept constructive guidance from wherever it is offered, but important that we do not lose control of this exercise. More importantly I see no reason not to proceed with what we are already planning.
