Leeds Festival - Proof of Residence

The Parish Council needs to check that only residents of the Parish receive the tickets at the specially reduced price. If you are allocated a ticket and you're not on the electoral roll, you will need to provide one of the following **original** documents as proof of your address. All documents must show your name and address.

- Current UK photocard driving licence (full or provisional)
- Current old style UK driving licence (full)
- Bank or building society statement or passbook (issued within the last 3 months or showing transactions within the last 3 months)
- Credit card or store card statement (issued within the last 3 months)
- Benefits Agency documentation confirming current receipt of benefits
- HMRC tax notifications or documentation issued within the last 6 months or for the current tax year
- Council tax bill (current year)
- Council or housing association tenancy agreement (current)
- Mortgage statement issued within the last 12 months
- Utility bill – e.g. gas, electricity, water, telephone but **not** a mobile 'phone bill (issued within the last 3 months)

If you're under 18 and don't have any of the above documents, the Parish Council will also accept the following:

- NHS medical card letter
- Child benefit letter
- Student loan letter or statement (confirming home address)
- HMRC letter confirming issue of National Insurance card
- Letter of introduction addressed to the Parish Council from a known school or college confirming you are a registered current pupil or student and your address. The letter must be on headed paper or bear the school or college stamp.
