APPLICATION FOR RESIDENTS' TICKETS**

The Leeds Festival organisers have given Aberford and District Parish Council 80 tickets, each valid for the 3 days of the festival. These are a way of thanking the residents for their patience for any disruption caused by the event.

If more than 80 tickets are applied for, the tickets will be allocated by way of draw from all applications received.

The proceeds from the residents' tickets will be used to benefit the parish.

Section A

IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND HOW TO APPLY FOR TICKETS

Please read carefully and follow the instructions accurately.

Applications which do not comply will be rejected without notice.

1. Only ONE application per household is permitted. The application may be for a maximum of TWO tickets. If applying for two tickets, both people must be resident at the same address.
2. Only people resident in the area of Aberford and District Parish Council ("the Parish Council") are entitled to residents' tickets. A person is resident if their permanent home address is in the area of the Parish Council.
3. All applicants who will be **aged 13 or over at the time of the Festival** must have a ticket.
4. Over 18s must be on the electoral roll at an address in the Parish Council or will be asked to provide other proof of residence. Proof of residence will be required for people aged 13-17 years. Please see the Parish Council website www.aberford-pc.gov.uk for acceptable forms of proof of residence.
5. Under 16s at the time of the festival **MUST** be accompanied to the event by an adult ticket holder. 16-17 year olds may attend together or on their own, but cannot accompany an under 16.
6. Children aged 5-12 at the time of the festival do not need a ticket but **MUST** be accompanied to the event by an adult ticket holder **and children's details including proof of age must be registered at the time of application. ID & PROOF OF AGE MAY BE REQUIRED UPON ENTRY TO THE EVENT.** Children under 5 are not required to be registered.
7. Names will be printed on residents' tickets. Residents' tickets are non-transferrable. **PHOTO ID MATCHING THE TICKET NAME AND PROOF OF RESIDENCE WILL BE REQUIRED UPON ENTRY TO THE EVENT.** Acceptable forms of ID for this purpose are:
 - Passport
 - EU Photocard driving licence
 - Proof of Age card bearing PASS hologram
 - National ID card issued by an EU member state
 - Ministry Of Defence ID card
8. Do not include anyone on your application who is not permanently resident in the area of the Parish Council. This includes friends, relatives or people who work in the area. If you do, your entire application will be rejected.
9. Signed and completed application forms must be returned to the Parish Council at the address provided by **30th APRIL 2022.**
10. Unsigned/incomplete application forms will be rejected without notice.
11. **PAYMENT:** Residents' tickets are at the reduced price of **£65 each** (price set by Festival Republic). The venue and date for the draw (if required) will be advised in due course. Once this is finalised we request that all applicants attend the draw so that, if successful, full payment for tickets can be made at the draw. Tickets can be paid for in cash or by cheque made payable to **Aberford & District Parish Council**. If you are unable to attend the draw, please send a representative with your ticket money.
12. Please provide a contact e-mail address. If successful, the Parish Council will contact you via email with information regarding ticket despatch. Please also provide a telephone number.
13. Ticket winners will be emailed directly and the information will also be posted on the Parish Council website www.aberford-pc.gov.uk as well as on the Parish Council noticeboards.
14. All tickets will be supplied by the promoter by e-mail **approximately one week prior to the event and will be for the use of the named residents only who will be required to adhere to the conditions of issue. - E. All tickets will be supplied by the promoter approximately one week prior to the event for the use of the named residents only, who will be required to adhere to the conditions of issue. Details of all terms and conditions are published on the website www.leedsfestival.com.
- F. Tickets are non-transferrable and names will be printed on the tickets.
- G. Once residents' tickets are confirmed, there will be no exchanges or refunds.
- H. Ticket holders will be required to show photographic proof of identity at the event.
