

# Aberford Masterplan

Map of Existing Conditions and Potential Improvements relating to Traffic, Noise, Air Quality and Flood Risk Management

Footway build-outs at points to be agreed with the Local Highway Authority, along Main Street to reduce traffic speeds.

Implementation of parking restrictions and resident only parking bays to regulate the location of parking along Main Street (subject to consultation with the Local Highway Authority).

Community Shuttle Bus to/from Garforth train station in morning and evening peak periods.

Improvement of Bus Stop Infrastructure with bus maps timetables, shelters where necessary.

Setting up of an Aberford car sharing website or the promotion of the Leeds Car share website.

Monitoring of pollutants by Highways Agency at worst case locations facing the A1(M) in Aberford.

Introduction of tactile paving at the Main Street/Cattle Lane and Main Street/Highfield Road junctions.

Further Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) (Possible locations include the Main Street/Cattle Lane and Main Street/Lotherton Lane junctions).

Flood Zone 3 runs along the flow path of Cock Beck and the River Crow in Aberford.

Implementation of 20mph speed limit zone beginning immediately after the Main Street/Beckside and finishing immediately north of the village green area (Opposite Becca Lane).

Parlington Lake restoration proposal

Existing Noise Attenuation Fencing; Potential Noise Attenuation Fencing/Bund.

Existing concrete carriageway surfacing ( ) which could potentially be upgraded to Low Noise Surfacing subject to Highways Agency approval and funding.

Potential pedestrian refuge island crossing points or footway built outs at the following locations (●) within the vicinity of:

- Main Street/Lotherton Lane;
- Main Street within vicinity of Cattle Lane junction;
- The Arabian Horse Pub/Fields Lane; and
- The Royal Oak pub.

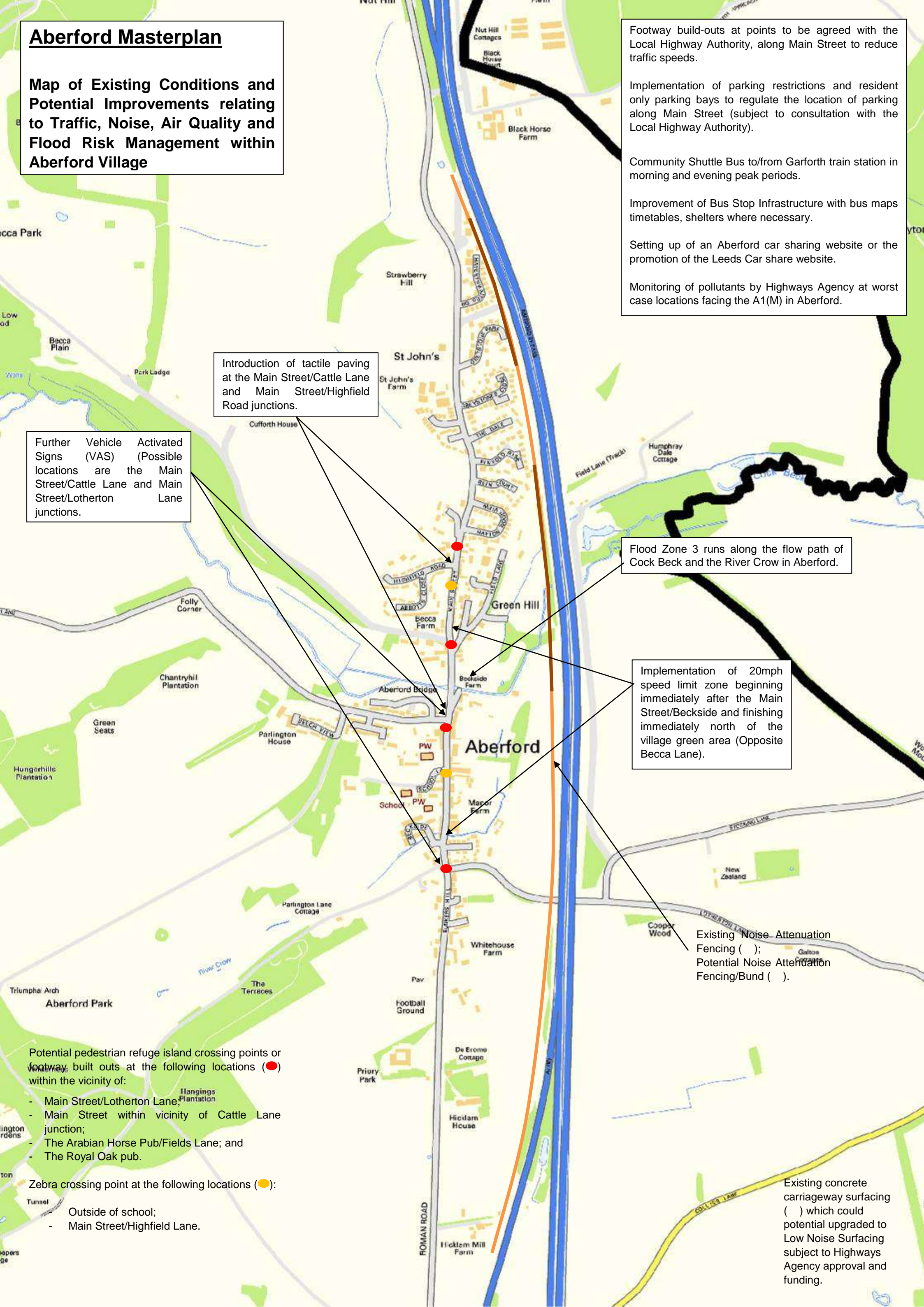
Zebra crossing point at the following locations (●):
