For the: **Elmet & Rothwell - Leeds Central - Leeds East - Leeds North East - Leeds North West - Leeds West - Morley & Outwood and Pudsey** constituencies

1. An Election is to be held for **one** Member of Parliament to serve each of the eight constituencies listed above.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the (Acting) Returning Officer, **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** or online from www.leeds.gov.uk/elections.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD** on any day after the date of this notice, between the hours of **10am to 4pm** but **no later than 4pm on Thursday 11 May 2017**.
4. The £500 candidate deposit can be paid by legal tender, bankers draft or by electronic bank transfer. Please contact Electoral Services on **0113 3784419** for more details of how to make a deposit by bank transfer.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 8 June 2017** between the hours of **7am** and **10pm**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD**, or for those electors from the **City of Wakefield, Electoral Services, County Hall, Wakefield WF1 2QW** by **12 midnight on Monday 22 May 2017**.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD**, or for those electors from the **City of Wakefield, Electoral Services, County Hall, Wakefield WF1 2QW** by **5pm on Tuesday 23 May 2017**.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD**, or for those electors from the **City of Wakefield, Electoral Services, County Hall, Wakefield WF1 2QW** by **5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017**.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, Level 2, Town Hall, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 3AD**, or for those electors from the **City of Wakefield, Electoral Services, County Hall, Wakefield WF1 2QW** by **5pm on 8 June 2017**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May 2017**.
